


Prostatitis

This is an inflammatory condition or infectious disease of the prostate. In many cases it is age related, and is common in older, entire male dogs. It can occur in desexed dogs but is rare. Desexing in most cases will prevent development of prostatitis and is an important and effective part of treatment for prostatitis in entire dogs. It is usually only part of the treatment, as there may be more than one factor causing the prostatitis.

Common causes are:

- Age related
- Associated with benign prostate enlargement (hormonal cause)
- Parasites (Mycoplasma canis, Leishmania spp. Brucella canis)
- Bacterial infection
- Neoplastic (less than 5% of patients with prostatitis have cancer)
- Prostate cysts
- Fistulas

The combined action of age (older dogs), prostatic enlargement (due to hormones) and bacterial infection are the most common causes.



Signs

Prostatitis can cause infertility but you would not be aware of this unless you had a stud dog and he wasn't getting bitches pregnant.

Signs an owner might notice are:

- blood or purulent discharge from the penis or prepuce or in the urine
- fever, lethargy



- sometimes inappetence
- sometimes abdominal pain
- may be straining (to pass urine or faeces)
- Stilted gait
- May be painful swollen testes
- Recurring urinary tract infection

Tests

Usually your vet will do a rectal exam to check the prostate. A urine test will be done. If any doubt about diagnosis, an xray or ultrasound of the prostate is done and a sample of prostatic fluid can be obtained for testing.

Treatment

Desexing is very effective at reducing the size of the prostate and improving the resolution of prostatitis. Alternatives to desexing are: 1) hormone injections (tardak) – this will only last about 3 months, 2) implants – suprelorin – this will last about 12 months, however desexing is the most effective option.



If the cause is a bacterial infection there is a blood- prostate barrier that not all antibiotics can cross. There is a pH difference (blood pH 7.4 and prostatic fluid pH 6.4), different plasma protein – binding characteristics and differences in lipid solubility. The best drugs are: enro-floxacin (baytril) and trimethosporin- sulphonamide (TMS). At least 10 days treatment is advisable and if prostatitis has been going on for a long time then expect to need 6 weeks on antibiotics. Ideally prostatic fluid should be obtained and cultured to check the best antibiotic to use and then another sample obtained after antibiotic course is finished and cultured to check all clear. If your dog is difficult with tablets then your best option is to have him desexed and have a long acting antibiotic injection into the prostate at the time of surgery. Prostatic cysts do require surgery, luckly they are not common. Prostatic abscess can occur, with an infection that is not picked up early or if treatment is not effective. This is when further test are likely to be needed. Often surgery is required as well as along course of antibiotics. Prostatic cancer luckly is rare in dogs, unfortunately it is an aggressive cancer that spreads to other parts of the body early and the outcome for any treatment is poor.

Prostatitis is in most cases fixable – but as with most health problems, best to be treated adequately and as early as possible.
