Open Show Critique

THE CAVALIER KING CHARLES SPANIEL CLUB OF NSW INC Open Show 28th May 2023

CLASS 1 - Baby Puppy Dog

1st Place - Exh No. 1

4 month Blenheim. Active baby with a gentle expression. Well balanced and short-coupled. A large dark eye spaced, well apart, well-laid shoulders moderately boned with a good spring of rib, level Topline, Tail well set on, free moving with good drive.

2nd Place - Exh No. 2

A very active Blenheim. Gentle expression, large dark, round eye. Moderately boned, well ribbed, had length in loin, level topline, tail set on. Typical baby movement is very active.

CLASS 2 - Mino Puppy Dog

1st Place - Exh No. 4

7 month Blenheim, a gentle expression, pleasing headpiece with dark eyes. Well laid shoulder, length in loin. Level Topline, moved well.

CLASS 3 - Puppy Dog

1st Place - Exh No. 5

An 11 month ruby, well-boned and proportionate body. A little reserved in temperament. Pleasing head, well ribbed, short-coupled level topline, a little restricted in movement in class. Moved better in line up.

CLASS 4 - Junior Dog

1st Place - Exh No. 7

Active 14th Blenheim, graceful with a lovely gentle expression. Dark eyes with good cushioning. Neck moderate into well-laid shoulders. Good spring of ribs, level topline, tail set on. Moved with good reach coat long and silky well presented.

2nd Place - Exh No. 8



13 month old. Well broken up Blenheim. Pleasing head, lovely long feathered ears, moderate length of neck, moderate body, tail carried a little higher. Moved well.

CLASS 5 - Intermediate Dog

1st Place - Exh No. 9

An active, graceful, dog of moderate proportions. Well broken up with a gentle expression. Good length of neck into shoulders moved with free-flowing reach and drive. Well presented with a soft silky coat

CLASS 10 - Australian Bred Dog

1st Place - Exh No. 12

Blenheim dog that was well balanced, with a gentle expression. Head pleasing with dark eyes. Well cushioned. Well-placed long ears. Moderate neck into well laid shoulders good spring of rib into short loin. Well-muscled. Level topline, set on tail. Moved well coat soft and silky. Well presented.

2nd Place - Exh No. 11

A pleasing Blenheim, well-broken up coat of good texture. An active dog that moved well. Was a moderately boned, well-ribbed back, short loin, and strong hind quarters.

3rd Place - Exh No. 13

Active, well-broken-up dog. Pleasing headpiece, gentle in expression, well-laid shoulders, well-ribbed back, good length in loin, coat in good condition.

CLASS 11 - Open Dog

1st Place - Exh No. 16

A well-balanced Blenheim adult, very active spaniel. Moderate bone and proportions. Pleasing headpiece, neck well laid with shoulders. Well, sprung ribs short coupled with level firm topline set on the tail, free moving with reach and drive. Excellent coat soft and silky well condition.

2nd Place - Exh No. 18

A well-broken-up tricolor. Active boy of moderate bone. Good spring of rib. Short coupled moved well.



CLASS 1 - Baby Puppy Bitch

1st Place - Exh No. 19

Tricolor baby is an active typical outgoing baby. Gentle expression, moderate length of neck into well-laid shoulders. Well ribbed into loin. Level topline set on tail. Well broken up with color points. Moved with free movement.

2nd Place - Exb No. 22

Blenheim baby of active happy demeanors, pleasing headpiece, neck moderate into the well-laid shoulder, well ribbed, level topline, tent set on. More solid in color, moved free and happily.

3rd Place - Exh No. 24

A lovely Blenheim baby. Pleasing headpiece, moderate neck into well-laid shoulders, good spring of rib into the loin. Moved well.

CLASS 2 – Minor Puppy Bitch

1st Place - Exh No. 30

A well-balanced minor. Active, pleasing feminine head with dark eyes, well set a part moderate neck, moderate bone, good spring of rib, level topline, set on tail. Moved free flowing.

2nd Place - Exh No. 29

A pretty little girl, active of moderate bone. Pleasing head, well broken up moved well.

3rd Place - Exh No. 33

A very active little girl. Moderately boned. Pleasing head. A little unsettled but moved freely.

CLASS 3 - Puppy Bitch

1st Place - Exh No. 34

A ruby girl of moderate proportions, well balanced, strong muscular girl, pleasing head, gentle expression. Well-moderate into the well-laid shoulder. Well-sprung ribs into a short loin. Unsettled a little but moved well and relaxed.

2nd Place – Exh No. 36



Another ruby girl, an active girl of moderate bone. Moderate neck into well-laid shoulder back topline moved freely.

3rd Place - Exh No. 35

Black and Tan, active girl, a very shiny coat with good rich tan markings. A little unsettled in moving.

CLASS 4 – Junior Bitch

1st Place – Exh No. 38

Blenheim girl has well broken up of moderate bone. A pleasing headpiece with a gentle expression, moderate length of neck into well-laid shoulders. Good spring of ribs short coupled. Tail is a little clamped today. Moved freely.

CLASS 5 – Intermediate Bitch

1st Place – Exh No. 44

Pleasing active girl, moderate proportion. Headpiece with soft expression, dark eyes. Moderate neck into well-laid shoulders good spring of ribs, short-coupled level topline, set on the tail, moved free and flowing.

2nd Place – Exh No. 40

Blenheim girl of moderate proportions. Head pleasing with dark eyes and gentle expression. Well-ribbed and short-coupled. A little unsettled today.

3rd Place - Exh No. 39

Ruby girl of good proportions. A little thinner in the bone. Pleasing head, with dark eyes. Moderate length of neck, with moderate angulation, a little unsettled as well.

CLASS 8 – Limit Bitch

1st Place - Exh No. 47



Active Blenheim girl. Well balanced of moderate proportions. Pleasing head Neck into well-laid shoulders, good spring of ribs short coupled. Level Topline, set on tail. Strong hindquarters. Moved soundly.

2nd Place – Exh No. 45

Active, rich Blenheim, well broken up girl, balanced of good proportions. Pleasing head, neck into shoulders, well spring ribs, level topline. Moved well.

3rd Place - Exh No. 46

Tri-Colour girl in good coat condition and moderate proportions. Moved well.

CLASS 10 - Australian Bred Bitch

1st Place – Exh No. 51

Black and Tan of moderate proportions. Active and well-balanced with gentle expression. Moderate length of neck into well-laid shoulders, well sprung ribs level topline, moved well.

2nd Place - Exh No. 50

Blenheim girl is a little out of condition, pleasing headpiece, and a good length of neck. A little unsettled today. Free moving.

CLASS 11 - Open Bitch

1st Place - Exh No. 54

Active, well-balanced of good proportions. Pleasing head, dark eye. Well-laid shoulders, good spring of ribs short coupled, level topline, tail set on moved freely with reach and drive.

Ruby bitch of moderate bone and well-proportioned. Pleasing head, neck transitioned into shoulders, good spring of ribs, level topline, moved well, coat in good condition.
