Just under 6mth old Ruby male who is full of the breed features I look for, lovely cushioning to the muzzle and a fabulous dark eye and he also had the correct ear set to finish of this lovely head, also super sound on the move coming and going one to watch out for in the future.

2nd Alexabelle Royal Heirloom

Another from the same kennel but just a little younger, well marked blenheim of which was rich in colour, but still needs more time to full out in his head portions . This young baby also needs to settle more on the move,

Class 2

1st Spenellie Welcome to The Party

7th month old Ruby with a very good outline balance already at this young age and also very sound on the move, very good top skull and ear set, of which he had a very good expression which finished off the lovely head, another to watch for in the future.

2nd. Toyman Catch Me If You Can

Blen dog of same age as class winner who carries very good breed type, also with very good expression and lovely eyes but carries a very strong under jaw of which his teeth placement needs to come right of which could do in time, I just preferred the overall soundness on the day of the class winner.

Class 3

1st Merseyport The Sazophonist

Only the one in this class, but a very well balanced young male who also carried a very good head, lozenge on top of the skull between the ears not seen often but always a pleasure to see, and rich Blenheim colour well broken, he has very good balance and lay back of shoulder of which he was also very sound on the move, another to watch for in the future.

Class 4.

1st Alexabelle Hey Mr Kot Tair

A wonderful class of five junior dogs and all a pleasure to judge, as listed the winner of this class and had very good sized teeth which not seen to offen in our toy breeds matched with the expression I am looking for and the head shape, and very good top line which he carried on the move with good soundness

2nd Belliari Louisvuitton Instyle

A very good type of Ruby and very good size, just needs to settle more on the move, as he was very out going in temperament which is good for the breed, very good head shape and eye colour another to watch in the future.

3rd Already written

Class 5

1st Ch Burford Talk About You At Caribelle

Another very high quality Blenheim of which his colour was well broken, 20mths old who matches this with such a very good out line and balance, and very sound on the move with great shoulders and this shows on the move with a very strong top line and tail set, his hind movement matches his front very sound. He also carries a lovely head shape and expression and well filled under the eyes, which I love in this breed.

2nd Kandccamo Music To My Eyes

This young male who is also built on very good soundness and very good expression and head shape just slightly heavy in overall build to the class winner.

3rd Lookingglass Dancing Fever

Another well balanced and size male who also carries a very good head shape and eye also a very good rich colour Blenheim on the day I feel he could have been in better weight.

1st Piccino Kryptonite

A 16 mth old dog of very good broken Blenheim colour, carries a very good out line on the move as this boy has very sound shoulders and front, little strong in his expression for me but he does have a good head shape and ear set, very sound male on the move.

four year old male tri, shown on the day in very good coat, he is a little too heavy in style for me and does not carry the shoulder placement of the class winner.

Another well balanced male 2.5 years old, well marked and also very good head shape and good breed type and style and he is also a very good size, and I just liked the over all type of the class winner.

Blenheim who was slightly heavy in type to class winner but shown in very good coat and condition on the day, free standing this boy has very good breed type but on the move his top line could be stronger and carries a very high tail set, but also another with a very good head shape and skull.

KIDNEY DISEASE

When is this likely to happen in my dog? In most cases, kidney disease is the result of ageing; it is simply a "wearing out" process. The age of onset is related to the size of the dog. For most small dogs, the early signs occur at about 10-14 years of age. However, large dogs have a shorter age span and may go into kidney failure as early as 7 years of age. In some breeds, there is a genetic predisposition to kidney failure. Young animals can have congenital kidney problems – but this is rare. What changes are likely to occur in my dog?

What changes are likely to occur in my dog?

The kidneys are filters. When ageing causes the filtration process to become inefficient and ineffective, blood flow to the kidneys is increased in an attempt to increase filtration. This results in the production of more urine. To keep the dog from becoming dehydrated due to increased fluid loss in the urine, thirst is increased; this results in more water consumption.

Thus, the early signs of kidney failure are increased water consumption and increased urine production. The signs of more advanced kidney failure include loss of appetite, depression, vomiting, weakness, lethargy, diarrhea, weight loss and very bad breath. Occasionally, ulcers will be found in the mouth. In severe cases, a dog may be weak, have muscle tremors or collapse.

How is kidney disease diagnosed?

The diagnosis of kidney failure is made from blood and urine test. Blood test checks the level of two waste products in the blood: blood urea and blood creatinine and phosphate levels. Urine tests are also helpful including urine concentration.

Often in early stages, kidney disease can't be detected in blood test, up to 70% of function of kidneys will be lost before blood test show the problem. So, kidney disease can be hidden until it is advanced. In some cases, the kidneys are worn out so that they cannot be revived. However, with appropriate treatment some dogs will live for several more months or years.

Treatment occurs in two phases.

1: The first phase is to replace fluid and electrolyte losses and "restart" the kidneys. Large quantities of intravenous fluids are given to "flush out" the kidneys. This flushing process, called diuresis, helps to stimulate the kidney cells to function again. If enough functional kidney cells remain, they may be able to adequately meet the body's needs for waste removal. Fluid therapy

includes replacement of various electrolytes, especially potassium. Other important aspects of initial treatment include proper nutrition and drugs to control vomiting and diarrhoea. Your dog will need to be in hospital for a few days on an IV drip.

2: The second phase of treatment is to keep the kidneys functioning as long as possible.

Each patient is an individual and your vet will stage their kidney problem and decide on the best course of treatment. This may include:

1. A moderate protein diet. This helps to reduce ammonia levels and usually makes your dog feel better. There are a variety of commercially prepared foods that have the quantity and quality of protein needed by your dog. Good options are: Hills k/d and Royal Canin Renal. Change foods gradually – start with $\frac{1}{4}$ of new food and $\frac{3}{4}$ of old food and over 2 – 4 weeks increase amount of new food. Alternately you can make your own pet food from things your dog likes:
 - i. Limit the amount of meat, fresh and all proteins (this also limits phosphorus which is important)
 - ii. Limit salt
 - iii. Increase the amount of fat and carbohydrate in the diet. Try things like toast, butter, oil, jam, cream, cheese, chicken skin or bones (with only small amount of meat), ice cream, yoghurt, Devon. It is important that your dog is eating. They need enough calories to not lose weight. Pets that don't eat, don't do well. They can have wet or dry food as long as they are eating. It is also important that your pet drinks enough. You may need to add water to their food (like gravy) to get their water intake up.

To encourage your pet to drink, consider:

- Lots of water bowls
 - Full measure of water (full bowl is more attractive)
 - Dripping tap or water fountain as pets often prefer running water
 - Ice cubes
 - Gravy, gels, soups, broths or stock
2. A phosphate binder. Phosphorus is removed from the body by filtering through the kidneys. Once the filtration process is impaired, phosphorus begins to accumulate in the blood. This also contributes to lethargy and poor appetite. Certain drugs will bind excess phosphates in the intestinal tract, so they are not absorbed, resulting in lower blood levels of phosphorus. This helps to reduce nausea and makes your pet feel better.
 3. A drug to regulate the parathyroid gland and calcium levels. Calcium and phosphorus must remain at about a 2:1 ratio in the blood. The increase in blood phosphorus level, as mentioned above, stimulates the parathyroid gland to increase the blood calcium level by removing it from bones. This can be helpful for the sake of the normalising calcium: phosphorus ratio, but it can make the bones brittle and easily broken. Calcitriol can be used to reduce the function of the parathyroid gland and to increase calcium absorption from the intestinal tract. This is recommended if there is evidence of abnormal function of the parathyroid gland.

4. If your pet has high blood pressure (which is very common with kidney disease) then their medication to reduce their blood pressure are very important.
5. Supplements, vitamin B & C should be supplemented. Some pets will need a potassium supplement as well.
6. A drug to stimulate the bone marrow to produce new red blood cells. The kidneys produce erythropoietin, a hormone that stimulates the bone marrow to make red blood cells. Therefore, many dogs in kidney failure have a low red blood cell count, or anaemia. This makes your dog feel weak, often drugs are need it improve this.
7. If you pet has protein loss or high levels of phosphate or metabolic acidosis often more medication, will be needed.

How long can I expect my dog to live?

The prognosis is quite variable depending on response to the initial stage of treatment, your ability to perform the follow-up care and your dog's willingness to eat the special diet. Treatment can be effective. Many dogs will have a good quality of life for months or even years. Early detection and early therapy are the best options. All dogs over 10yrs should have a yearly blood and urine test. If your pet is drinking a lot, it is a good idea to test ear
