

The production of the 2020 Yearbook is progressing well. We have a number of stunning adverts submitted and approved.


The Yearbook will be available at the Club's Easter Show and delivered there after via Australia Post. Advertisers will receive their copy via these methods as elected.

The Australian brushfires of 2019-2020 have significantly impacted many communities across Australia, and though we are a small club, we have not been without our scares, with many members forced to evacuate their homes.

Over the pond in the UK Barry Medford, (owner of Westgate Giftware) was on a well deserved holiday away from his busy business and saw the Australian Bushfire tragedy on the television.

He was stunned at the fires and great loss of our wildlife. He thought that with all the business the Australians have given him over the years that it was his turn to help out.

Barry has purchased some Koalas that were auctioned off and raffled at the CKCS Club shows he attended recently.



His first raffle winner was Sue Mangham at the Northern Cavalier Club, also held on the day was a loose change bucket, which raised 124.GB Pound. Money generously donated on the day by the Committee, Judges, exhibitors and spectators. This will was added to the total of the first auction.

Norma Inglis was also working hard alongside Barry and has organised the first on-line silent auction. This auction raised 1,000 GB Pound. Which in turn converted to \$1,839.95.AU\$... WOW!!



All the money will be donated to the Koala Hospital at Port Macquarie.



I think you will have to agree that our Cavalier lovers over "The Pond" have supported Barry and given so generously to help our beautiful Koalas get the treatment they require. Also future breeding programs and other assistance they need.
