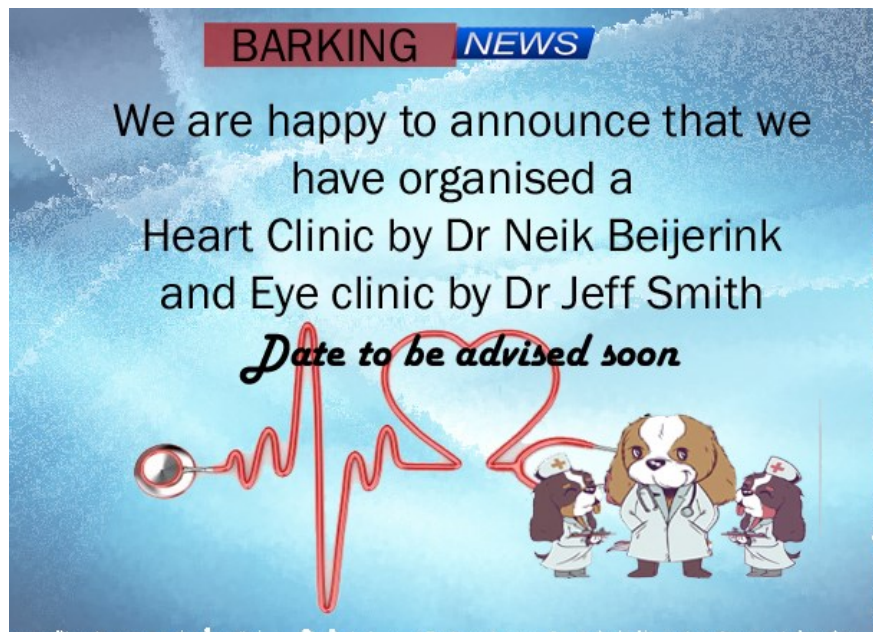

Minor Puppy Dog

1st Place – Cavalierlove Illicit Affair

Blenheim male, active with a gentle expression. Correct flattish skull with shallow stop and well-developed lips. Large, dark, round eye. High set ears. Forelegs straight. Good coat and colour for a young male. Prefer level topline, more hind angulation and parallel rear movement.

Puppy Dog

1st Place – Kaliak Look At Me

Blenheim male, active, graceful, well balanced. Correct head and gentle expression. High set ears. Level back. Correct silky coat and good colour. Tail in balance with body. Prefer more free and elegant movement.

Junior Dog

1st Place – Tikimi Scandal In The Wind

Tricolour male, well-balanced with gentle expression. Correct head with lips well padded. Large, dark round eye. High set, well feathered ears. Well angulated, good spring of rib, level back. Well cushioned & feathered feet. Tail balanced with body. Good long silky coat. True moving fore and aft. Prefer more active, elegant on the move.

2nd Place – Belljari Louisvutton Instyle (ai)

Ruby male, active, well balanced. Correct flattish skull, large round eyes and high set ears giving gentle expression. Would prefer slightly more developed lips and fill under eye. Well angulated, short coupled with a level back. Would prefer parallel hind quarters and well cushioned feet. Correct silky coat of good colour. Free moving and elegant.

3rd Place – Alexabelle Tuxedo Impressions

Tricolour male. Gentle expression. Correct flattish skull, shallow stop, well-developed lips. Large dark eye and high set, well feathered ears. Would prefer more turn of stifle and better hind movement. Correct silky coat of good colour.

Intermediate Dog

1st Place – Ch Tikimi Royal Obsession

Blenheim male, active, graceful and well balanced. Correct head with gentle expression and well-developed lips. Large, dark eye. Correct long, well feathered, high set eyes. Well angulated on correct cushioned feet. Good spring of rib and short coupling. Correct long, silky coat of good colour. Would prefer more rear drive and level back.

Limit Dog

1st Place – Kaliak Covid Shenanigans

Tricolour male, active, graceful and well balanced. Correct head, large round eyes and high set, well feathered ears giving a gentle expression. Forelegs straight on well cushioned, compact feet. Would prefer feet untrimmed. Good coat texture and colour Free moving and elegant, would prefer tail carriage lower on the move.

2nd Place – Shahrami Indiana Jones

Blenheim male, well balanced. Correct head with gentle expression. High set, well feathered ears. Well angulated, good spring of rib, but would prefer shorter coupling. Correct long silky coat of good colour. Would prefer an active, free moving and elegant gait.

Australian Bred Dog

1st Place – Ch Alexabelle Reign Supreme

Blenheim male, active, graceful and well balanced. Correct head and gentle expression. Dark, round eye and high set ears. Short coupling. Correct compact, cushioned feet. Good long silky coat of good colour. Tail balanced with the rest of the body. Free moving and elegant on the move.

2nd Place – Ch Caperway The Moon Is On Ice

Blenheim male, active, graceful with gentle expression. Correct almost flat skull and shallow stop. Well developed lips. Good dark round eye and high set ears. Forelegs straight and shoulder well laid back. Good compact, cushioned well feathered feet. Prefer more turn of stifle/drive from hind and level back.

3rd Place – Elvenhome Love Actually

Blenheim male, well balanced, gentle expression. Correct flattish skull, well developed lips. Dark eye, well-spaced. Ears set high and well feathered. Tail well balanced with the body. Good long silky coat of good colour. Prefer shorter coupling and more active and elegant on the move.

Open Dog

1st Place, Best Dog and Best in Show – Sup Ch Alexabelle Billy Elliot

Blenheim male, active, graceful and well balanced. Excellent head and gentle expression. Well-developed lips and well filled under large, round, dark eye. High set, well feathered ears. Well angulated fore and hindquarters. Good spring of rib and level back with short coupling. Tail in balance with the body. Correct long silky coat. Excellent movement overall with true, sound, movement fore and aft, typical free moving and elegant with good rear drive.

2nd Place and Reserve Dog – Sup Ch Cavalierlove Scandalous Affair

Blenheim male, well balanced, active, graceful. Correct flattish skull and shallow stop. Good dark round eye and high set ears. Typical gentle expression. Well angulated fore and hindquarters. Good spring of rib and short coupling. Correct compact, cushioned feet. Good long silky coat and colour, evenly marked on head. Free moving and elegant. Would prefer level topline on the move.

Baby Puppy Bitch

1st Place – Cavalierlove Love Game

Tricolour female, well balanced, active, graceful. Correct head and expression. Correct compact feet. Good colour and coat with feathering for age. Good free moving and elegant gait.

2nd Place – Zicatella Crystal Vision

Blenheim female, well balanced, graceful. Correct head, evenly marked and gentle expression. Good dark eye and high set ears. Prefer shorter coupling. Correct free moving and elegant gait.

3rd Place – Elvenhome Irresistible

Blenheim female, active, graceful. Correct head, evenly marked with valued lozenge. Good compact, cushioned feet. Would prefer more developed lips and shorter coupling. Correct free moving and elegant gait.

Minor Puppy Bitch

1st Place and Reserve Bitch – Caperway Devil In Disguise

Blenheim female, active, graceful and well-balanced. Correct head and gentle expression. Good dark, large, round eye and high set ears. Well angulated, good spring of rib and level back. Correct silky coat, well-furnished for age and correct white & rich chestnut colour with unique lozenge spot. Free moving and elegant gait.

2nd Place – Edenridge Magic In The Mist

Blenheim female, well balanced, active with a gentle expression. Forelegs straight. Well angulated, level topline. Compact, cushioned feet. Good coat, well-furnished. Tail in balance with the body. Free moving.

3rd Place – Cavalierlove Scandalicious

Blenheim female, correct gentle expression with good large dark round eye and high set ears. Good compact, cushioned feet. Correct silky coat of good colour. Would prefer shorter coupling and level topline.

Puppy Bitch

1st Place – Cavalierlove Royal Fascination

Blenheim female, good head and expression with large dark round eye and high set ears. Prefer more bone, fore and hind angulation and shorter coupling. Compact feet. Good silky coat texture and correct Blenheim markings. Free moving and elegant. Prefer parallel rear movement.

Junior Bitch

1st Place, Best Bitch and Runner Up to Best in Show – Alexabelle DeJavu

Blenheim female, active, graceful and well balanced. Good head and gentle expression with large round eye and high set, well-feathered ears. Forelegs straight, well angulated fore and hindquarter, correct moderate bone, good spring of rib and level topline. Excellent long silky coat, well feathered. Free moving and elegant gait, very sound and true fore and aft.

2nd Place – Alexabelle Icy Minx

Blenheim female, well balanced. Correct flat skull, dark round eye and high set ears. Good topline. Prefer well laid shoulder and well-turned stifle. Tail in balance with the body. Correct silky coat texture and Blenheim markings. Correct free and elegant movement. Prefer parallel fore and aft.

3rd Place – Blakesleigh Sunrise Splendour

Ruby female, correct almost flat skull with high set ears and large, round eye. Forelegs straight. Would prefer level topline and more turn of stifle. Correct compact feet and tail in balance with the body. Would prefer free moving.

Intermediate Bitch

1st Place – Kaliak Celestial Kiss

Ruby female, well balanced. Correct head and expression. Large, dark, round eye and high set ear. Forelegs straight with compact feet. Correct silky coat, rich red in colour. Prefer more feathering. Correct free moving and elegant gait. Would prefer parallel rear.

Limit Bitch

1st Place – Leisureview Loliegobilblisboom

Blenheim female, active, graceful and well balanced. Correct gentle expression. Dark, round, large eye and high set ear. Well angulated, level topline and short coupling. Correct silky coat with good Blenheim markings.

Elegant on the move.

2nd Place – Kaliak Back In The Black

Black and Tan female, active, well balanced. Large, dark round eye and high set ears giving gentle expression.

Well angulated, good spring of rib and level topline. Prefer shorter coupling. Correct silky coat and raven black and tan markings. Free moving and elegant gait. Would prefer parallel rear.

3rd Place – Blakesleigh Mystery Angel

Blenheim female, well balanced, gentle expression. Good Blenheim markings with unique lozenge spot. Good dark, round eye. Correct high set ears. Well angulated. Level back. Prefer more compact feet. Correct long silky coat. Prefer more active, elegant on the move.

Australian Bred Bitch

1st Place – Jadamvale Ethereal Reign

Blenheim female, active, well balanced. Correct head, large, round eye with gentle expression. Good spring of rib and level topline. Correct silky coat text and Blenheim markings. Tail balanced with body. Free moving and elegant. Would prefer true moving fore and aft.

Open Bitch

1st Place – Jadamvale Mystic Reign

Blenheim female, active, graceful. Correct head and gentle expression. Good large, dark, round eye. Correct moderate bone, spring of rib and level back. Prefer shorter coupling. Tail balanced with the body. Correct long silky coat text of white and rich chestnut colour. Free moving and elegant gait. Would prefer truer movement in the rear.

2nd Place – Ch Leisureview Fever Of Love

Blenheim female. Well balanced with gentle expression. Correct almost flat skull, shallow stop, round/dark eye and high set ears. Forelegs straight, moderate chest and level back. Correct compact, well feathered feet. Tail in balance with the body. Would prefer active and free moving gait.

3rd Place – Elvenhome Flora McDonald

Blenheim female, well balanced with gentle expression. Good dark, large, round eye and high set, well feathered ears. Correct moderate bone, good spring of rib. Correct long, silky coat and good rich chestnut markings. Prefer more active, graceful and free moving.

Neuter Dog

1st Place, Best Neuter Dog, Best Neuter in Show – Exh No. 42

Tricolour male, well balanced. Correct head, large dark round eye and high set ear giving correct gentle expression. Forelegs straight, correct moderate bone and compact feet. Prefer level topline. Tail in balance with the body. Good silky coat and colour. Correct free moving and elegant gait.

Open Neuter Bitch

1st Place, Best Neuter Bitch, Runner Up Best Neuter in Show – Exh No. 43

Blenheim female, well balanced, gentle expression. Large dark round eye, high set ears and well-developed lips. Well angulated fore and hind quarter. Prefer level back. Tail in balance with the body. Heavily coated, would prefer silky texture. Free moving and elegant.

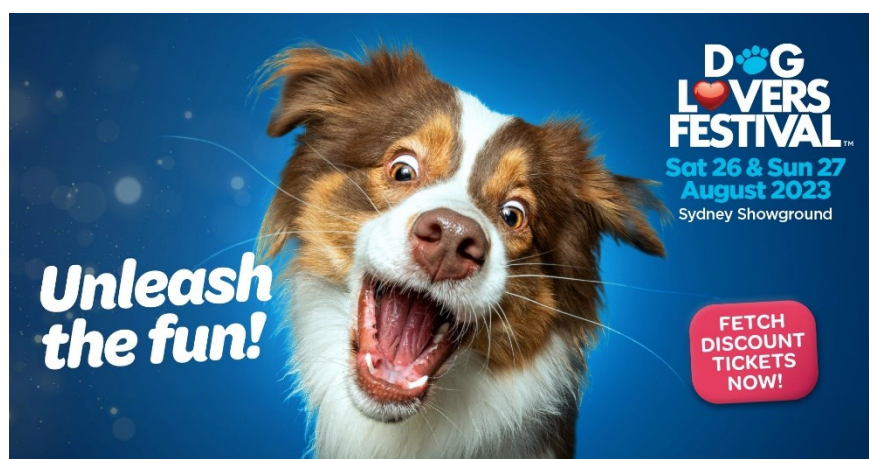

CBD Oil or Medical Cannabis

CBD oil contains Cannabidiol. This is the most effective part of the Cannabis plant for relief of inflammation and other therapeutic uses. The concentration in CBD oil is 98%-100% pure CBD isolate. It does not contain THC (Tetrahydrocannabinol) or other parts of the Cannabis plant which can cause psychotic effects. This means it does not give the patient a “high” or intoxicating effect and is safer for patients.

CBD acts on the Endocannabinoid system (ECS) of the body. This system interacts with many body functions including the Nervous System. CBD receptors play a critical role in balancing neurochemical responses including pain, inflammation and anxiety. It is of particular benefit for chronic pain.

CBD Oil has shown benefit for many conditions that have not responded well to conventional care.

CBD Oil is beneficial for:

- Osteoarthritic pain
- Chronic pain
- Anxiety
- Skin conditions
- Age related cognitive dysfunction
- Poor appetite
- Inflammatory conditions
- Seizure/Epilepsy
- Cancer pain
- Palliative care and support

CBD Oil is considered a safe medication. Adverse side effects are uncommon. Cases of poisoning are from human recreational products which contain THC and can cause vomiting and diarrhoea, stumbling gait, agitation, seizure, depression and coma.

It is possible for your pet to experience sleepiness or diarrhoea when they first use medicinal CBD. It is important to advise your vet if you suspect any side effects.

There are many different products available that are marketed as CBD Oil. Many are less than 5% CBD oil or contains all parts of the Cannabis plant including THC. If it is available without a prescription then it is a low concentration and not likely to do much. Full spectrum CBD contains all parts of the Cannabis plant including THC. Broad spectrum CBD contains multiple Cannabis compounds, but not THC, so is not psychoactive. CBD isolate is pure CBD with no other Cannabis compounds. This is what we use for pain relief and has many known benefits. Hemp seed oil is a completely different product, it is extracted from the seeds of the plant. It has omega oils,

antioxidants' and has some nutritional benefits, and can improve skin and coat, but does not have any significant pain relief benefits.

CBD oil is a prescription only product so you need to discuss its use with your vet. Vets can compound CBD oil or can write a script for you to get it online.

CBD oil is non-intoxicating. It has a very low potential for addiction and is safe for prolonged use.

There are lots of claims for uses of CBD oil. It is important to look at the source of any claim and only seriously consider those made by scientific professionals.

CBD oil is best used together with other medical and surgical care.

Beware when buying CBD oil as not all oils are the same.

1. You need a prescription (or else it is a low concentrate product) or to get it from a vet.
2. Don't buy based on price-quality, purity and what is in the product matters.
3. Don't buy something that may be contaminated with pesticides, herbicides, heavy metals or any other additives.
4. Buy as an oil so you can adjust the dose readily.

If you think your dog could benefit from CBD oil then talk to your vet.

We do prescribe and compound CBD oil here in house at Menai Animal Hospital. It is necessary for a pet to have been checked over by us and had a recent blood test before it is prescribed. Cost for a small dog (under 10kg) is about \$100 per month.
