Lick Granulomas

A lick granuloma is a lesion on the skin formed due to frequent and excessive licking. Often the problem is on the top of the forearm, above the paw. Often there is hairloss and red ulcerated skin, sometimes with scabs, often thickened.

There are many factors that can start off a lick granuloma such as: pain (may be bone or joint pain), nerve pain, a wound, bacterial infection, furunculosis (ruptured hair follicles), allergy, mites, behaviour issues including boredom. It is important where ever possible to try to work out what

started the problem so this can be treated adequately. Although excessive licking perpetuates the problem, often this is not what started it. This usually means a skin scraping to check for mites and a biopsy if there is any risk of deep fungal infection or neoplasia or if not improving with treatment. Xrays may be needed if any underlying bone or joint problems or osteoarthritis or neoplasia. Blood tests are adviseable if ulcers are present and not healing.

High dose of antibiotics are needed usually (double dose) as often infection is deep and walled off (in chronic fibrosis) at least 4 weeks on antibiotics will be needed and 6-8 weeks are often necessary. Often these infections are multi-drug resistant, so more than 1 antibiotic may be needed and a swab (or tissue) for culture and sensitivity may be needed to show best choice of drug.

In most cases glucocorticoids (cortisone) are needed at the same time as antibiotics. This is because your pets body will often react to inflammation from ruptured hair follicles and ruptured apocrine glands within the skin by being very itchy. Antibiotics will be needed for longer than cortisone but both for at least the first 2 weeks. (up to 3 months treatment can be need in severe cases)

You will need to have some way of preventing your pet from licking the problem area. This may be an Elizabethan collar, a bandage or sock or sometimes using a layer of super glue (but beware, some dogs will just lick around this and then you get a bigger lesion). If you are able to find something that tastes so horrible your pet won't lick it off, this may be enough. Good luck trying.

Some pets need meds and/or behaviour modification training. to modify their obsessive compulsive licking. Talk to your vet if you think your pet needs this. It always helps to spend more time with your pet actively playing and exercising and avoid confining your pet. You may consider getting a companion for your pet. Sometimes behaviour medications reduce anxiety and compulsive behaviours amd make life better. Each dog is different and discuss with your vet what will work for your pet and you.



For long standing lesions, laser or radiosurgery treatment may be what makes the differenece. Talk to your vet about how this may be the answer for you. We have found laser treatment very helpful.
