IMPORTANT - Letter from the Committee

The following correspondence re-published from the previous Newletter.

As per recent communication, the Annual General Meeting has been delayed till October 19th due to the COVID-19 crisis in in Sydney and the Greater sydney areas.

Recently the Club Committee held a Meeting.

Among the ordinary items for discussion around the upcoming show, the Committee met to discuss the upcoming AGM and election of Office Bearers and Committee. Election of Office Bearers and Committee members is done by formal ballot at the AGM. A number of the existing Club Committee have indicated they do not wish to stand again, at the next AGM and the Committee is concerned that unless people stand we will have no Committee or Office Bearers to carry forward as a viable club.

As per the Club Constitution: https://www.cavalierclubnsw.com/ethics-and-rules:

Part III – Item 24. There shall be a Committee consisting of the Office Bearers and eight members.

Part III – Item 73. The Office Bearers of the Club shall be: (a) the President for the time being of the Club who, unless otherwise determined by the members, shall not hold office for more than three (3) years in succession; (b) Two Vice-Presidents (c) The Treasurer (d) The Secretary

This letter is to notify members that people will need to nominate for these positions, including the Office Bearer roles as well as potential Committee positions. Unless these positions are filled at the AGM the Club may have to modify how it functions. It may be necessary to reduce Club activities to a minimum, or windup the Club.

The Committee felt it important to advise the Club of the following impacts should the Club no longer be viable and is to be wound up.

- The loss of a well-recognised and trusted Breed Club that has made the introduction of and contributions to the Cavalier breed in NSW and Australia. The history of which covers over a half century of promoting, showing the breed and educating the public. Our history is documented via the Yearbooks which have been donated to the Library of Dogs NSW.
- 2. The loss of participation in Club Championship Shows and point scores.
- 3. he loss of a successful Rescue Service that has been able to rescue and rehome many dogs, young and old; sickly and healthy over time.
- 4. The loss of the Website, Newsletter and Yearbook, catering to both the Club Members and the general Public.
- 5. The loss of Club organised gatherings such as the Fun and Information day and attendance at Dogs NSW Exhibitions and Open Days and other commercial exhibitions such as Sydney Dog Lovers Show.
- 6. The loss of Club organised Health Clinics to support Club members.
- 7. The loss of financial contributions to Health studies conducted by reputable



organisations for the betterment of the breed.

The Committee discussed possible ways forward to alleviate the load on any future Committee. Members are encouraged to discuss these options and contribute ideas in other ways to keep the viability of the Club.

Options include the following:

Option 1: At the AGM, members nominate and stand to fill all positions – the Club continues as normal.

Option 2. The Club reduces its annual workload by limiting the number of shows and other activities.

Option 3. The Club eliminates all shows. This is drastic, but the Club is not required to run shows, under Dogs NSW regulations

Option 4. Running the Club as purely, a member and public information resource, by keeping the website and its content, as well as running the Rescue Service as its main financial entity.

Option 5. Positions needing to be filled are: President 2 Vice President Treasurer Secretary 8 Committee positions (present committee members may stand again)

Having said all that, the Committee is keen for the Club to continue, but we must have members nominate and stand, to fill positions in the Committee and as Office Bearers.

All positions within the Committee will be available. Some positions we can confirm will have existing members who wish to continue, if there are multiple nominations for a position, election will be via the Club's election process. Election of Office Bearers and Committee detailed in the https://www.cavalierclubnsw.com/ethics-and-rules, Part III - Items 40 – 51

The Club will run a specific agenda for the General Meeting directly after the AGM to discuss viability options pending the outcome of elections at the AGM. Any final decision made by the Club will be voted on at a General Meeting and will be based upon all members inputs and if the worst case does arise, any process that involves the case of winding up the Club will be governed by the relevant Regulations and Acts that the Club is bound to.

Baby Puppy Dog

1st Kaliak Covid Shenanigans. 3 month old, well marked Tricolour. Sweet head and expression with lovely round dark eye and well set ears. Great mouth for one so young. Compact. Tended to look up at his handler, causing his front to lift but once settled, used what he has quite well. Good temperament. **OPPOSITE BABY IN SHOW**

2nd Lookingglass Saturnus. 4 month old Blenheim. Bigger overall and more mature than first. Nice dark eye and head proportions. Scissor bite. A longer cast puppy but with good topline and moves out well. Good temperament.

3rd Belljari Here Comes The Sun. 3 month old Ruby. Another sweet expression, good eye and scissor bite. Would have preferred a little more neck to balance him out but moved very well and had a super topline. Good temperament.

Puppy Dog

1st. Caperway Serenade. 8 month old well marked Blenheim. Nice dark eye and ear set but lacking fill of muzzle to give gentle expression. Scissor bite. Top line was rising towards the rear but that could be the age and it may balance out as he finishes growing. Moves out well going round and has a good temperament. **OPPOSITE PUPPY IN SHOW**

Intermediate Dog

1st Leisureview Black Bob Creek. 19 month old, richly marked Black and Tan of good breed type. Correct head proportions with dark eye and high set, lovely feathered ears. Scissor bite. Moved well in front but closer behind. Good temperament. **OPPOSITE INTERMEDIATE IN SHOW**

Limit Dog

1st Kandccamo Ice Cold By Knight. 18 month old, well marked and coated Blenheim of good breed type. Correct head proportions and gentle expression with lovely dark and well placed eye and correctly set and well furnished ears. Scissor bite. Good neck into shoulder and nice spring of rib. Was a bit unsettled when first on the move but moved freely and with great drive once he got going. Good tail set. Good temperament. **DOG CC & BIS**



Australian Bred Dog

1st Caribelle Don't Forget Me. 2 year old, well marked and coated Blenheim, again of good breed type. Excellent head proportions and ideal expression. Large dark eye, well placed and furnished ears. Scissor bite. Enough neck, good bone and elegant on the move. Good temperament. **RES CC & AUSTRALIAN BRED IN SHOW**

Open Dog

1st Ch Elvenholme Fever Pitch (Al). 3 year old, well marked and coated Blenheim dog. Up on size but still with required elegance and good breed type. Good head proportions with large dark eye and well framing ears. Scissor bite. Good body with good spring of rib. Clean and elegant on the move – best mover of the class. Good temperament. OPPOSITE OPEN IN SHOW

2nd Ch Cavalierlove Proud N Cool. 3 year old, well broken and coated Blenheim dog. Good expression with large dark eyes and well set ears. Scissor bite. Didn't move away as cleanly as 1st but moved well on the go around. Good temperament.

3rd Ch Kaliak Captivation. 3 year old, well marked tricolour dog. Not as gentle in expression as first and second but still with nice dark eye and well placed ears. Scissor bite. Another one closer behind but quite elegant on his move around the ring. Good temperament.

Baby Puppy Bitch

1st Spenellie Butterflies Run Free. 4 month old, rich ruby bitch. Lovely type of puppy, good proportions all over and well balanced. Sweet and gentle expression. Good mouth – scissor bite. Moves very well for a baby. Good temperament, BABY IN SHOW.

2nd Elvenholme Flora McDonald. 3 month old, well marked Blenheim bitch. Another lovely type of puppy, very close in the decision – I just preferred the over all head proportions on 1st, however another bitch with very sweet expression. Moved very well also. Good temperament.

3rd Dapsen Shake Rattle And Roll. 5 month old, well marked Blenheim bitch. More mature than 1st & 2nd . Good head proportions. Scissor bite. Starting to go a little bum high but she is growing and this will probably settle with age. Good temperament.

Minor Puppy Bitch

1st Caperway Catch A Fairy.

6 month old, well marked Blenheim bitch. Good breed type with good head proportions and expression – large dark eye and good ear placement. Scissor bite. Good neck into shoulder. Moves cleanly and with elegance. Would prefer a fraction more leg under her. Good temperament. **MINOR IN SHOW**

2nd Kandccamo Somebody To Love. 7 month old, well marked Blenheim bitch. Good breed type. Longer in muzzle than first but expression still pleasing. Longer in body but still well bal-



anced for her age. Moves well when settled. Good temperament.

3rd Alexabelle Too Sweet To Touch. 6 month old, well broken Blenheim bitch. Good type. Large dark eye and good ear but her mouth was undershot today. Moved very well. Good temperament.

Puppy Bitch

1st Elvenholme Isabela McDuff. 9 month old, well marked Tri Colour bitch. Good type with pleasing head and expression. Her mouth was slightly undershot today but prefer her head type to that of 2nd. Needs to develop in front but otherwise was well balanced. Moved very well. Good temperament. **PUPPY IN SHOW**

2nd Konavan Shes Got The Power. 9 month old, Ruby bitch of good colour and coat. Not as good In head as 1st, would prefer more cushion and less length to the muzzle. Scissor bite. Large, dark eye and good ear placement. Drops off a little over the croup and moves a bit close behind. Good temperament.

Junior Bitch

1st. Caribelle Icy Whispers At Caperway. 14month old, well marked and coated Blenheim bitch. Good breed type. Good head proportions with good expression. Scissor bite. Good neck into shoulder and top line. Moved very well. Good temperament. RES CC & JUNIOR IN SHOW

2nd Kaliak Fatal Attraction. 13 month old, well marked Blenheim bitch. Good type. Not as mature as 1st. Good head proportions with large dark eye and good ear set. Scissor bite. Longer in body but allows her to move well and with elegance. Good temperament. Shahrami Catherine Of Aragon. 17 month old, well broken Blenheim bitch. Good head proportions but white of eye distracts from her expression. Scissor bite. A little unsure of herself and this affects her movement.

Intermediate Bitch

1st Ch Lookinglass Enchanted Flame. 2 year old, well broken and coated bitch. Good type. Won the class on the final go around, moved cleanly and with elegance. Good head proportions, although I would prefer a darker eye. Scissor bite. Excellent front. Good temperament. INTERMEDIATE IN SHOW

2nd Cavalierlove Cool Splender. 2 year old, well broken Blenheim bitch. Good type. Good head proportions with pleasing expression. Scissor bite. Not as good in front as 1st but moved cleanly behind. Good temperament

3rd Blakesleigh Musical Mystery. 18m old, well broken Blenheim bitch. Smaller bitch – would prefer more of her overall. Dark eye and good ear set. Scissor bite. Moves a bit close on the away. Good temperament.



1st Shahrami Brandi Alexander. 2 year old, well coated Blenheim bitch. Good type. Up to size but was still elegant on the move – best mover in class. Good head proportions – sweet expression. Longer through the body. Good temperament. **OPPOSITE LIMIT IN SHOW**

2nd Blakesleigh Mystery Angel. 2 year old, well broken Blenheim bitch. Smaller over all than 1st – would prefer more bone & more head. Scissor bite. Shorter coupled than first. Moves a bit close behind. Good temperament.

3rd Kaliak Designer Girl. 12 month old, well marked blenheim bitch – needs to mature. Was of good size. White of eye takes away from her expression, otherwise good head proportions. Scissor bite. Did not move as cleanly coming or going as I would have liked. Good temperament.

Australian Bred Bitch

1st Ch Kandccamo Designed By Knight. 3 year old, well marked and coated Blenheim bitch. Good type. Sweet expression with very dark eye and good ear placement. Scissor bite. Good coupling. Was a little wide through the front and would prefer a tad more leg. Moved well. Good temperament. **OPPOSITE AUSTRALIAN BRED IN SHOW**

2nd Blakesleigh Woodstock Legacy. 20 month old, well marked tri colour bitch. – Needs to mature. Longer in muzzle than first – would prefer more fill. Longer in body but better leg under her. A little close moving away. Good temperament.

Open Bitch

1ST Belljari Age Of Adeline. 2 ½ year old, ruby bitch of good type. Correct proportions of head with nice dark eye and ear set. Scissor bite. Nicely balanced throughout with great neck into shoulder and good top line. Not quite in full coat but what she had was enough on the day. Moved very well. Good temperament. **BITCH CC & RUBIS /OPEN IN SHOW**

Neuter Bitch

1st Ch Kaliak Femme Fatale 6 year old tricolour - well marked and in excellent condition. Good type. Well balanced throughout and moved very well. Scissor bite. Good temperament. **NEUTER IN SHOW**
